Note : Attestation should be done by two Gazetted Government servants or two or more person of respectability in town taluka or village in which the applicant. To be furnished in case the applicant is not literate enough to sign his name. In the case of re-marriage of the widow while applying for family pension on behalf of the minor child, the widow should (i) the date of her remarriage (ii) name of the Treasury at which payment is desired (i) her full address in the application for family pension is not necessary to a furnish a fresh application for document as they are already available with the pension papers on which family pension was originally admitted.
